You have the ability to manage large volumes of data from multiple sources to help the business make key decisions.

You will work collaboratively with operational, research and clinical teams responding to requests for data, conducting data analysis and providing timely high-quality reports and actionable insights. A key element of the role is to provide advice to clinicians with regards to their research design and statistical/data science aspects of their grant applications/ proposals.

You are passionate about how data and digital transformation can play in improving clinical and patient outcomes. In addition, you have:

- Tertiary qualification in statistics, computer science, mathematics, data science, or a related field.
- Advanced skills in Excel and SQL.
- Demonstrated experience analysing large volumes of data from multiple sources.
- Experience in data warehouse, business intelligence implementation and deployment of organisation wide reports and dashboards
- Experience with cloud platforms e.g. Microsoft Azure, AWS.
